Dear Parent/Carer,

Firstly, a thank you for your continued support during the school closures. It has certainly been a challenging and worrying time for everyone.

All children from tomorrow will have access to remote learning – this is a legal requirement, as per the previous national lockdown, and children should be accessing work online each day.

Staff have worked hard to set up the Google Classroom home learning links and will be providing children with Maths, English, Topic, Phonics (KS1), videos, quizzes and live feedback from teachers. We will also be sending out some booklets to support home learning- further information to follow later this week.

To access home learning children, need to do the following:

- Type into Google- ‘Google classroom’ and select the first link
- The sign in button is in the top right corner ‘sign in’ and select classroom
- Children should then enter their school email address and password E.g first.surname@oldbankacademy.co.uk- this can be found stuck in the front of their planner. If your child only has first.surname add @oldbankacademy.co.uk to make it an email.
- If they haven’t already joined the classroom, please enter the code text to you. This will enter them into the specific classroom needed to access relevant work.
- Once into their google classroom they will find instructions and work uploaded from their class teacher. All children have been shown how to do this in school and some have already accessed this during isolation periods.
- The work provided will vary depending on the age and key stage of children & this work will initially be provided for the next 3 days and then weekly from Monday 11th January.
